

Horseshoe Risk Assessment

COVID 19 19th July 2021

Summary

As of 19th July 2021, COVID restrictions in England are lifted. We, *The Employer*, have the responsibility to protect our Staff and Customers. Therefore we require all persons within the premises to make themselves aware of our risk assessment. Our aim is to restrict any spread of the virus and allow any of those vulnerable to seek comfort within The Horseshoe.

Those with COVID symptoms spreading the virus within the premises.	All Staff, Customers and Visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask all persons with symptoms or been asked to self isolate to stay at home. • Sanitise all well used areas. 	All Staff and Customers.
Those approaching the bar causing an outbreak.	All Staff, Customers and Visitors.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sanitise the bar regularly. • Ask all those vulnerable to wear a mask. • Serve all those vulnerable at the table. 	All Staff and vulnerable customers.
Large groups of people causing an outbreak of the virus.	All staff, Customers and Visitors.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At all reasonable times, try to keep all larger groups separate from others. • Ask that limited numbers of people of the larger groups to approach the bar. 	All staff and customers.
Those without masks causing an outbreak in the premises.	All staff, Customers and Visitors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • We ask anyone who is classed as vulnerable to wear a mask and sit at their table at all times as we serve them. • Anyone showing symptoms of the virus, we ask they stay home. 	All staff and customers.

Although no longer legally required, we will retain the NHS Track and Trace QR Code for all those vulnerable to “Check In” to The Horseshoe.
